Did you know that according to the Community Transportation Association of America, approximately 3.6 million Americans miss or delay medical care because they lack appropriate transportation to their appointments? Whether it's because of a lack of financial resources or reliable and affordable transit options, care for the most vulnerable populations can be fragmented, unmanaged and uncoordinated.

At Morris Hospital, we feel that everyone in our community deserves reliable access to medical care. That's why 21 years ago we created our Patient Transportation program. Since inception, our buses have logged more than 2.5 million miles and provided more than 256,000 trips to and from medical appointments. At Morris Hospital, we think everyone deserves reliable access to medical care. In 1998, we made sure of it by starting our own free Patient Transportation service.

21 years, 2.5 million miles, and more than 256,000 trips later, our Patient Transportation program still has an incredible impact on thousands in our community. But, none of this would be possible without generosity. EVERY SINGLE RIDE is made possible through donations. Some donate their time by driving a bus. Others make monetary donations to help cover the costs of the program. Our annual Auxiliary Golf and Cards Tournament is another way to support those who need help getting to and from their medical appointments. This year's goal for the annual tournament is \$56,000 and we need your help. Gifts of ALL SIZES mean a lot to us.
